Round table: Scope Interpretation – Rare Matrix vs. Tissues Moderators: Steve & Salvatore

Comments:

- > Discussion focused on tissues & "rare" fluids (e.g. CSF, tears, BAL, vitreous humor)
- Very uncommon where this is primary matrix
- > As an "additional matrix" it is important to understand end use of the data
- Understood that we analyse tissue homogenate and not tissue
 - Recovery never known (in absence of radiolabel)
 - Stability can only be assessed in homogenate
- Cannot apply all elements of M10
- Use surrogate matrix for calibration standards where possible

Recommendation:

- Understand Context of Use
- > Apply Scientific/fit for purpose validation

Action:

Revisit EBF publications on Tissues (2014) and SV (2015) in the context of tissue analysis post M10
